

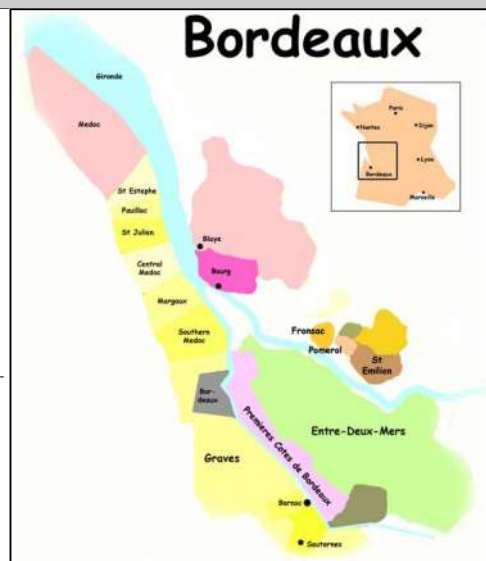

Brand Highlights

- Non-negotiant. Family owned and vinified from the oldest grapes only.
- Aged in oak for 14 months and then 2 years in the bottle prior to release.
- 67% Cabernet Sauvignon, 31 % Merlot, and 2% Petit Verdot

The Estate

Haut Grignon is located in the Medoc region. Château Haut Grignon belongs to Bruno Segond, who also owns Château Lousteauneuf a little Cru Bourgeois widely distributed in Europe, Japan and Canada. The winery has been modernized and expanding over the past 30 years.

Wine Making

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot are hand harvested at full ripeness, carefully vinified and then aged in one third new French oak barrels for 14 months prior to a traditional egg white fining and bottling.

Tasting Notes

Nice bouquet of black fruit and cedar. The palate is medium-bodied with firm tannins and a touch of spice. This is a fine wine that is drinkable in its youth and could age well. It displays all of the rich and powerful character of a classic Medoc.
