

### The Estate

Our philosophy has always been to over-deliver for the price...but today in order to get good fruit, and out-standing bulk, you have to pay a little more (even though there is excess). I have hired a coordinator/oenologist who lives in Healdsburg, so now I can be tipped off faster to top parcels available. We believe that our "niche" is with Cartlidge & Brown, Heron, and ....and remember there are a lot of Bob's and Robert's out there.

We buy about 50 to 60% of our needs as grapes and custom crush them at a rented facility in Sebastopol. Then I blend in different lots that I feel will greatly upgrade our base and add complexity.

### Wine Making

These grapes are from three growers and four vineyards dotted along the course of the Russian River in Mendocino County, Potter Valley, Redwood Valley and Hopland. It comes from 100% Organically grown fruit. We have blended in 1% Roussanne and this wine has a North Coast appellation. After a traditional fermentation in temperature controlled stainless steel, 50% of the cuvee is aged for six months in second and third fill oak. That portion goes through malolactic fermentation.

### Tasting Notes

It is delicate and dry with a pop of apple/pear fruit, a hint of softness, with a touch of river-rock minerality.



### The Estate

### Wine Making

The grapes from this vintage come from the Sacramento Delta Region and Lodi. The growing season began cool and wet but was moderate for the balance and created a small and concentrated crop. This is a blend of 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Petite Syrah, and 10% Petit Verdot. After a cool 80 degree fermentation in tank, the wine was aged in second and third fill oak for 5 months to polish the tannins.

### Tasting Notes

It is full-bodied and intense with the typical dark red fruits Cabernet is famous for. The nose is raspberry with hints of chocolate, deeply colored with notes of cassis, plums and medium weight frame.
