## The Best of the Roussillon



The Roussillon had a cool, late year in 2013 and the resulting wines show uncommon elegance and freshness paired with beautiful concentration. And while a relatively small region (well, when compared to the Languedoc anyways), there's incredible diversity in its terroirs. The two blockbuster Grenache releases from Calvet-Thunevin and Department 66 couldn't be more different from the more granite influences Bila Haut RI Syrah.
