

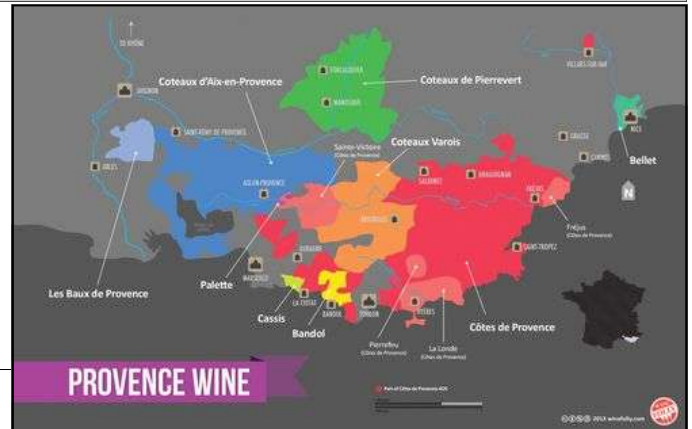

Brand Highlights

- Family owned and operated since 1974
- 52% Grenache, 18% Cinsault, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Counoise, 5% Syrah, 5% Sauvignon Blanc, and 5% Viognier.
- Eouve means beautiful tree where the vineyard is lined by oak trees.

The Estate

The domaine is situated 22km north-east of Aix en Provence on the Roman road that linked Marseille to Apt. The 32 acres of vineyards average in age of 25 years, and are in the heart of an authentic and preserved natural environment and Provencal terroir. It is owned by the Mans family who acquired the property in 1974 and run with great care and precision by Jean-Patrice Margnat. The primary soil is limestone-clay and stony matrix.

Wine Making

The grapes are picked in coolness of the early morning to preserve the freshness as much as possible. Limited skin contact is defined by the variety and vintage and the clean must is then racked to stainless steel for low temperature fermentation. Production of this wine is less than 3,000 cases and the wine is bottled with less than 3 grams per liter of residual sugar.

Tasting Notes

The wine is a lovely rose petal pink color. The nose of the wine reveals aromas of red fruits and white flowers. It has an engaging and well balanced mouthfeel, full of elegance and finesse with a lingering finish.
